

Library Accommodation Working Group: Third Report

1) Introduction

This Report is the result of actions by the Working Group since the November PPC meeting.

2) Short-term and medium-term actions

- a) **Library bookstock** most of the books from the former open-access Library have been donated to the Christian Aid book sale, and a smaller reference collection has been selected for shelving in the study within the Presbytery.
- b) **Chairs** The Music Group now leave their chairs and equipment set up between Masses, so storage in the former Library is no longer an issue.
- c) **Disposal of duplicated/unwanted Music equipment** this has been completed.
- d) **Storage of music stands, music and other necessary music equipment** *see b) above*
- e) **Other short-term actions as listed in preliminary report to PPC** Considerable further progress has been made in clearing and de-cluttering this accommodation: some able-bodied help is now required to shift remaining more bulky and heavy items, and an appeal for volunteers is proposed.

3) Re-instatement for use as a Chapel

The longer-term proposals in our Second report are currently on hold pending the outcome of discussions on the John Duncan mural, and investigation of the damp which had been discovered in the former Library as it was being cleared out.
